As previously notified, children in Years 5-8, Rooms 1,2,3,4, will be participating in Clubs programmes over 5 consecutive Wednesdays commencing Week 5- 15 August – 12 September. 1.00– 2.30pm.

Many thanks to all parents who have offered their assistance, in various ways. Clubs is always one of the highlights of the year for our pupils. <u>However we still</u> require parents who can assist with transporting a small group of children each week to a specific venue and back. If you can assist please notify me <u>as soon as possible</u>. As a result we are now able to offer a choice of 11 activities to the children as outlined below.

* These are approximate costs and may vary just slightly.

* Please help your child to choose a suitable club activity, bearing in mind the cost factor, interest shown and time involved to complete work. Please note that specific clubs may be for senior girls or boys only etc.

<u>N.B.</u> FOUR DIFFERENT CHOICES IN ORDER OF PREFERENCE <u>MUST BE MADE</u>. All pupils will be allocated to ONE of their 4 choices so they need to discuss carefully with parents as to their preferred choices before committing themselves to the return. Year 8 pupils <u>only</u> are given their first choice as a privilege.

N.B. PLEASE DO NOT SEND MONEY AS YET.

Included in the cost for each child will be a nominal amount to be given out to parents transporting a group of children. This will be given in the form of petrol vouchers at the end of the programme to parents who have assisted.

We would prefer you to purchase yourself -reimbursement will be made once a receipt is presented.
